AN ACT RELATIVE TO SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF OPERATOR'S
LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 29 of chapter ninety of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following new sentence: —

4 No operator whose license is revoked or whose right to
5 operate is suspended under this section shall be licensed again
6 nor shall his right to operate be reinstated within five years
7 after the date of the revocation of the license if it was not sus-
8 pended prior to such revocation, nor thereafter except in the
9 discretion of the registrar; provided, that the foregoing shall
10 not be construed to authorize the exercise of such discretion
11 contrary to any provision of section twenty-four.
