**AN ACT RELATIVE TO PENSIONS FOR WIDOWS OF POLICE OFFICERS AND
FIREFIGHTERS KILLED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 100, of Chapter 32, of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended by Chapter 318, of the Acts of 1970, is
- 3 hereby further amended by striking out in line 6, the words,
- 4 "and as the result of an assault on his person."
