In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-one.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR FIREFIGHTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of Chapter 32 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws to the contrary, a fire fighter, who after selecting  
3 an option other than Option "A" and having been retired,  
4 shall if his beneficiary dies, have the right to revert to  
5 Option "A."
