AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LAW CLERKS AT THE INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 23 of the General Laws as appearing in the Ter-
2 centenary Edition is hereby amended by adding the following
3 new section 15C: —

4 The chairman of the Industrial Accident Board shall ap-
5 point three members of the Massachusetts Bar who shall serve
6 full time as law clerks. They shall perform such duties as
7 the chairman shall require and receive such salary as the
8 chairman shall designate.
