Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The Board of Trustees of state colleges is authorized and 2 directed to sell and convey on behalf of the Commonwealth 3 to The Beth Israel Hospital Association, a charitable institu-4 tion duly organized and existing under the laws of the Com-5 monwealth, by deed approved as to form by the attorney gen-6 eral, for a consideration to be determined by the commis-7 sioner of administration to be the average of three appraisals 8 to be made by three qualified disinterested appraisers to be 9 appointed by the Greater Boston Real Estate Board, a cer-10 tain parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in the 11 city of Boston at the corner of Brookline Avenue and Long-12 wood Avenue and more particularly described as follows: 13 northwesterly by Brookline Avenue 295.48 feet; northeasterly 14 by land now or formerly of The Beth Israel Hospital Associa-15 tion 329.53 feet; southeasterly by Binney Street 306 feet; and 16 southwesterly by Longwood Avenue 327.79 feet; containing 17 98,816 square feet of land more or less, and being shown on a 18 Plan by Henry C. Mildram, Real Estate Engineer date August 19 28, 1928 recorded with Suffolk County Registry of Deeds
