AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF SERVICES ON THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1-5 of Chapter 81 App. of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking Clause f. and substitut-
3 ing therefor the following: —

4 To acquire sites abutting on the turnpike and to construct
5 or contract for the construction of buildings and appurtenances
6 for gasoline stations, restaurants, and other services and to
7 lease the same for the above purposes. No lease for gas sta-
8 tions or restaurants may be for a period exceeding ten years
9 from the inception date of such lease. Each restaurant loca-
10 tion and gas station location must be bid separately and leased
11 separately from the others. Any remaining terms and condi-
12 tions of such leases shall be at the discretion of the Authority.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1-10 of Chapter 81 App. of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and
3 substituting the following: —

4 The Authority is hereby authorized to fix, revise, charge,
5 and collect tolls for the use of the turnpike and the different
6 parts or sections thereof, and to contract with any person,
7 partnership, association, or corporation desiring the use of
8 any part thereof, including the right of way adjoining the
9 paved section for placing thereon telephone, telegraph, electric
10 light or power lines, gas stations, garages and restaurants, or
11 for any other purpose, and to fix the terms, conditions, rents,
12 and rates of charges for such use, except as limited by clause
13 f. of Section 1-5 of this Chapter.
