The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-one.

AN ACT IMPOSING A PENALTY FOR THROWING OR DROPPING OBJECTS
AT A VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 127 the following section: —

3 *Section 127A.* Whoever wilfully or maliciously throws or
4 causes to be thrown any projectile, missile, or object at a
5 vehicle shall be punished by imprisonment in a jail or house
6 of correction for not less than six months. The sentence im-
7 posed upon such person shall not be suspended nor shall any
8 person convicted under this section be eligible for probation,
9 pardon, parole or furlough or receive any deduction from his
10 sentence for good conduct.

11 A person found guilty of violating this section shall, in all
12 cases, upon conviction, in addition to any other punishment
13 be ordered to make restitution for the financial loss incurred
14 by reason of injury to person or property sustained as a result
15 of the commission of the crime.
