

ACTS, 1980. - Chaps. 253, 254.

Parcel 2-TS-1

A parcel of land in the Town of Charlemont, County of Franklin, supposed to be owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and under the care, custody and control of the department of environmental management, bounded and described as follows:-

Southerly, by the November 5, 1930 state highway layout, 238 feet;

Northwesterly by other land of the said Commonwealth of Massachusetts (department of environmental management), 66 feet;

Northerly, by other land of said Commonwealth of Massachusetts (department of environmental management), 130 feet; and

Northeasterly, by land now or formerly of the Boston and Maine Railroad, 65 feet.

Containing about 5,999 square feet of land, more or less.

Said lands are to be diverted by the department of public works from their present public use to the relocation of state highway route 2 in the town of Charlemont, under department's layout number 6437, more particularly for the construction of a bridge number C-5-24 over the Boston and Maine Railroad track-age.

Chap. 253. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN SERVICE BY ERNEST LIJOI, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF QUINCY, SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, Ernest Lijoi, an employee of the city of Quincy and a member in service of the retirement system of said city, shall be given full credit for retirement purposes for his prior service as a member of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority police upon payment into the annuity fund of said retirement system of an amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from his regular compensation had he been eligible for membership and been a member of such system during such prior service, together with regular interest to the date of payment.

Chap. 254. AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY.
