**AN ACT TO REGULATE CIGARETTE ADVERTISING DISPLAYED ON  
TAXICABS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 22 of Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by Chapter 694 of the Acts of 1968, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting, after the third paragraph, the  
4 following: —

5 No person shall display on any metered taxicab licensed  
6 under this section an advertisement for cigarettes.
