**AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 463 of the Acts of 1976,  
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the words "six  
4 months" in the twenty-seventh sentence of paragraph two and  
5 substituting in place thereof the words "three years."

1 SECTION 2. Section 9 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 478 of the acts of 1974,  
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the words "two  
4 years" in the fourth sentence of paragraph three and sub-  
5 stituting in place thereof the words "three years."
