AN ACT TO AMEND THE BAY STATE SKILLS ACT TO ALLOW LICENSED CAREER SCHOOLS TO PARTICIPATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 40 I of the Massachusetts General Laws, as so ap-
- 2 pearing, is hereby amended by striking out section (4) ("Ed-
- 3 ucational Institution") and inserting in place thereof the fol-
- 4 lowing section.
- 5 *Section 4.* "Educational Institution," a public secondary or
- 6 post-secondary institution, proprietary trade, business, voca-
- 7 tional, technical, professional or correspondence school licensed
- 8 by the department of education according to Chapter 75C,
- 9 Chapter 75D and Chapter 93 of the Massachusetts General
- 10 Laws, as so appearing, or an independent non-profit institu-
- 11 tion within the commonwealth authorized by law to provide a
- 12 program of skills, training or education beyond the secondary
- 13 school level.
