**AN ACT TO PROVIDE A COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE TO ELDERLY, BLIND,
AND DISABLED PERSONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Effective July 1, 1982, the combined level of state supple-
2 mentary payments authorized by section one of Chapter 118A
3 plus the level of federal supplemental security income for the
4 elderly, blind, and disabled shall be increased by ten percent.
