By Mr. Rotondi, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 966) of Samuel Rotondi and John Bilafer for legislation to further define who can register motor vehicles in Massachusetts. Public Safety.

**AN ACT TO FURTHER DEFINE WHO CAN REGISTER MOTOR VEHICLES
IN MASSACHUSETTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended as follows: by inserting at the end of the
3 first sentence the following phrase: "provided the owner is a
4 licensed Massachusetts driver".

1 SECTION 2. Said Section 2 of Chapter 90 is hereby further
2 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
3 sentence: — "In the event the motor vehicle is registered to
4 a corporation or any other non-corporate business entity, the
5 application must contain the name of a licensed Massachusetts
6 driver employed by the corporation or other non-corporate
7 business entity, said employee to be legally responsible for the
8 payment of all motor vehicle excise taxes incurred on behalf
9 of said corporation or other non-corporate business entity".

1 SECTION 3. Said Section 2 of Chapter 90 is hereby further
2 amended by striking out the words at the end of the second
3 sentence: — "if one has been issued".
