**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN THE CONTRIBUTORY  
RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 *Group 2* in paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 3 of  
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of  
3 chapter 626 of the acts of 1974, is hereby amended by strik-  
4 ing out, in lines fourteen and fifteen, the words, "of a municipi-  
5 pal department" and inserting in place thereof the following  
6 words: — or other municipal employees.
