The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-two.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF
MASSPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be a committee, to be known as the Community
2 Advisory Committee of Massport, to consist of fifteen mem-
3 bers who shall serve for terms of two years. Said Committee
4 shall promote and encourage the improvement of the facilities
5 of Massport with a special concern for the reduction of noise,
6 provided, however, that this act shall not be construed as
7 authorizing said committee to exercise any power, function or
8 duty conferred or imposed by law on any other committee, or
9 any department, board, commission, agency or officer. The
10 chairman of the committee shall be designated annually by
11 the committee members. The members shall serve without
12 compensation but shall be reimbursed for their expenses actu-
13 ally and necessarily incurred in the performance of their
14 duties. The committee shall be provided with suitable quarters
15 in the state house or elsewhere in the city of Boston. The
16 committee shall make an annual report to the general court
17 and a copy thereof shall be sent to the governor and the state
18 secretary.
