7 other employee economic benefits, including any increases pro-  
8 vided for by Section 99D of Chapter 276, as inserted by Sec-  
9 tion 71D of Chapter 393 of the Acts of Nineteen Hundred and  
10 Seventy-Nine, to which he would have been entitled had he  
11 lived and served until October 1, 1979.
