**AN ACT RELATIVE TO FREE SPEECH.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 53, as most recently amended by section  
3 20 of chapter 1073 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following section: —

5 *Section 53.* Common brawlers, disorderly persons, prosti-  
6 tutes, disturbers of the peace, keepers of noisy and disorderly  
7 houses and persons guilty of indecent exposure may be pun-  
8 ished by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for  
9 not more than 3 months, or by a fine of not more than  
10 (\$30.00) thirty dollars, or by both such fine and imprison-  
11 ment.
