AN ACT AUTHORIZING LICENSED PSYCHOLOGISTS TO PERFORM
CERTAIN GUARDIANSHIP EVALUATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 201 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by section 3 of chapter 845 of the Acts of
3 1974 is hereby further amended by adding the words "or
4 psychological" after "medical" on the third sentence, and by
5 adding the words "or one or more licensed psychologists"
6 after the word "illness" in the fourth sentence.
