AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE JUSTICES OF THE JUVENILE COURTS TO DISCLOSE THE IDENTITIES OF CERTAIN OFFENDERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF FOURTEEN AND SEVENTEEN YEARS, INCLUSIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or General
- 2 Law to the contrary, juvenile courts in the commonwealth
- 3 are hereby authorized to disclose the names of juvenile
- 4 offenders charged with offenses before said courts between
- 5 the ages of fourteen and seventeen years, inclusive.
