AN ACT RELATING TO THE JURISDICTION AND POWERS OF JUDGES
IN JUVENILE COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regula-
2 tion, judges of juvenile courts, and judges while sitting in
3 juvenile proceedings, shall exercise increased supervision and
4 discretion in determining the placement, treatment, transfer,
5 or discharge of juvenile offenders in foster homes or security
6 facilities.
