AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DESIGNATION OF CLERK OF THE EQUITY
PROCEEDINGS IN PLYMOUTH COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 61, as most recently amended by Chapter
3 384 of the Acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
4 lowing section: —

5 *Section 61.* The justices of the superior court may desig-
6 nate for a term of three years from the date of such designa-
7 tion, one of the assistant clerks for the County of Plymouth, to
8 perform, under the direction of the clerk of courts for the
9 County of Plymouth, the duties of clerk pertaining to the
10 equity proceedings of said court, who shall receive from said
11 county, in addition to the salary paid to him as an assistant
12 clerk a sum equivalent to five percent of the salary of the
13 clerk.
