By Mr. Lewis, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1920) of Arthur Joseph Lewis, Jr., for legislation to transfer the University of Massachusetts, Huntington Avenue facility in the city of Boston for the purpose of providing a campus for the Roxbury Community College and to continue a certain program at said college. AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS, HUNTINGTON AVENUE FACILITY IN THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A CAMPUS FOR THE ROXBURY COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND TO CONTINUE A CERTAIN PROGRAM AT SAID COLLEGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provision of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the University of Massachusetts
3 campus located on Huntington avenue in the city of Boston is
4 hereby transferred to the division of regional community col-
5 leges for the purpose of providing a campus for Roxbury Com-
6 munity College.

1 SECTION 2. The program of continuing studies which was in
2 existence at Boston State College on October first, nineteen
3 hundred and eighty-one shall continue at said Roxbury Com-
4 munity College.
