AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN A CERTAIN GENERAL LAW.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make a corrective change by the insertion of certain words in a general law which were inadvertently omitted, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 113H of chapter
2 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
3 the fourth sentence, as appearing in chapter 129 of the acts of
4 1982, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
5 Effective July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two such
6 governing committee shall consist of three members from in-
7 surance companies participating in the plan and two members
8 from associations of insurance producers appointed for terms
9 of six years, two members from insurance companies par-
10 ticipating in the plan and two members from associations of
11 insurance producers appointed for terms of four years, and
12 two members from insurance companies participating in the
13 plan and two members from associations of insurance pro-
14 ducers appointed for terms of two years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen
2 hundred and eighty-two.
