The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING PAY AND ALLOWANCES FOR OFFICERS AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 83 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 811 of the acts of 1977, is hereby amended by
3 striking out paragraph (b) and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing new paragraph: —

5 (b) For duty performed under the provisions of sections thirty-
6 eight, forty and forty-one, there shall be allowed and paid to
7 members of the armed forces of the Commonwealth from funds
8 appropriated therefor the same rate of pay for length of service and
9 basic allowances as if they were on active duty status in the armed
10 forces of the United States, however, such compensation shall not
11 be less than fifty dollars per day, subject, however, to the provi-
12 sions of subsection (c).
