AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING FEES FOR RESIDENTS AND NONRESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 83 of Chapter 130 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out section 230 of Chapter 572 of the
3 Acts of 1980 and replacing it with the following new section: —

4 *Section 83.* For the purpose of defraying the cost of the divi-
5 sion's research, management and other activities including adminin-
6 istrative and operating expenses, and the cost of issuing the fol-
7 lowing resident and non-resident permits and the inspection
8 relative thereto, resident and non-resident fees, the amounts which
9 shall be determined by the secretary of administration and finance
10 under the provisions of section three B of chapter seven for the
11 filing thereof, shall be paid to the director by the person to whom
12 the same is issued for any calendar year or part thereof.

1 SECTION 2. Section 80 of Chapter 130 of the General Laws as
2 most recently amended by Section 2 of Chapter 422 of the acts of
3 1971 is hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence of
4 the first paragraph and replacing it with the following new
5 sentence: — Notwithstanding any contrary provision as contained
6 in this section, a person who has in his possession a commercial
7 fisherman permit (rod and reel) may take by rod and reel or by
8 diving and sell finfish lawfully taken from the coastal waters.
