In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MINIBOND AUTHORIZATION FROM TEN MILLION DOLLARS TO TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS ANNUALLY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, to place abandoned property in the custody of
3 the State Treasurer, therefore it is hereby declared to be an
4 emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5 public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 49A of chapter 29, is hereby amended by striking out in
2 lines 10 and 11 the words "ten million dollars" and inserting in
3 place thereof the words: — twenty million dollars.
