## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROVIDING FOR REDUCED ELECTRIC RATES FOR LIFE SUPPORT EQUIPMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of public utilities is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to promulgate rules and regulations providing for a fifty
- 3 per cent reduction of the normal rate in the rate charged for
- 4 electricity for the running of any life support equipment.

It is the duty of the House to inquire into the conduct of the President and to report thereon to the Senate.

The Constitution of the United States

Article II, Section 4

The President, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States shall be removed from Office on Impeachment and Conviction.

Impeachment is the process by which the House of Representatives accuses a high official of the United States of a crime or misdemeanor.

The House of Representatives has the sole power of impeachment. The Senate has the sole power to try all impeachments.
