AN ACT INCLUDING A MUNICIPAL ASSESSOR FOR THE PROCESS OF PROMULGATING STANDARDS FOR ASSESSORS PERFORMANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
