AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL FULL-PHASE TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF UNION STREET, NORTH STREET, SOUTH MAIN STREET AND NORTH MAIN STREET IN THE TOWN OF RANDOLPH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
2 department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to
3 install and maintain full-phase traffic signals at the intersection of
4 Union Street, North Street, South Main Street and North Main
5 Street in the town of Randolph.
