AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD FOR DISABLED PERSONS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 1D the following section: —
- 3 *Section 1E.* The registrar shall furnish, at no charge, to every
- 4 person who presents medical evidence of a substantial physical
- 5 disability an identification card, which, when displayed by such
- 6 disabled person on the front dashboard of a vehicle so as to be
- 7 visible from the outside of the vehicle, shall have the same effect as
- 8 a distinctive number plate displaying the “International sign for
- 9 handicappers” issued pursuant to section two.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

As amended to January 1, 1919.

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
