AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PER DAY AMOUNT OF RENT ON WHICH AN EXCISE TAX SHALL BE IMPOSED IN HOTELS, LODGING HOUSES, AND MOTELS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section Three of Chapter 64G of the Massachusetts General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by deleting Sentence 2 of said Section
- 3 Three, and inserting in its place: — No excise shall be imposed if the
- 4 total amount of rent is less than fifteen dollars per day or its
- 5 equivalent.
