AN ACT TO ALLOW EDUCATORS TO SERVE ON VARIOUS HIGHER EDUCATION BOARDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by c. 402 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby  
3 further amended by deleting the eighth sentence in its entirety.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by c. 329 of the Acts of 1980, is hereby  
3 further amended by deleting the first sentence of the fifth para-  
4 graph in its entirety.

1 SECTION 3. Section 20 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by c. 612 of the Acts of 1982, is further  
3 amended by adding the following paragraph at the end thereof: —

4 This Section shall not prohibit an employee of any public educa-  
5 tional institution or school system from holding the position of  
6 trustee or regent of any of the institutions described in Chapter  
7 15A of the General Laws nor in any way prohibit such an employee  
8 from performing the duties of or receiving the compensation pro-  
9 vided for such office, if any; provided, however, that no such  
10 employee shall hold the position of trustee or regent of any institu-

11 tion by which he is employed and provided further that no such  
 12 member shall be eligible for appointment to such institution while  
 13 a trustee or regent thereof or for six months thereafter.
