AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PREMIUM TAX PAID TO SPECIAL INSURANCE BROKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 168 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended, is hereby further amended, by adding the following
3 sentence to the end of the first paragraph of said section: — The
4 person so licensed may charge the insured an amount equal to four
5 percent of the gross premium on account of the aforementioned
6 payment to the Commonwealth.
