## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE RATES CHARGED TO MOTORISTS WHO ARE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause (d) of Section 4 of Chapter 175E of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in Section 19 of Chapter 266 and  
3 amended in Chapter 511 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby further  
4 amended by inserting after the fourth paragraph:

5 For motor vehicle insurance rates for an insured who is physical-  
6 ly handicapped, who otherwise qualify for the lowest rate classifica-  
7 tion applicable to drivers generally, shall be twenty-five percent  
8 less than applicable rate for such classification.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to all motor vehicle insur-  
2 ance policies issued to become effective January first, nineteen  
3 hundred and eighty-four or thereafter.
