### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SUSPENSION OF POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 25 of Chapter 268A of the Massachusetts General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of the fifth paragraph, the  
3 following new paragraph: —

4 “This section shall not apply to police officers, who are charged  
5 with such misconduct as a result of the performance of their  
6 duties. Such actions shall be dealt with according to the  
7 provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 31, sections 41 and 43.
