AN ACT ADDING THE TOWN OF ASHBY TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF FITCHBURG.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 171 of chapter 478 of the acts of  
3 1978, is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph  
4 under the caption "Middlesex" and inserting in place thereof the  
5 following paragraph: —

6 The first district court of northern Middlesex, held at Ayer;  
7 Ayer, Dunstable, Groton, Pepperell, Townsend, Shirley, West-  
8 ford, Littleton and Boxborough.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 218, as most recently  
2 amended by section 170 of said chapter 478, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking out the ninth paragraph under the caption  
4 "Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the following para-  
5 graph: —

6 The district court of Fitchburg, held at Fitchburg; Fitchburg,  
7 Ashburnham, Lunenburg and Ashby.

1 SECTION 3. For the purposes of all civil and criminal matters  
2 related thereto, the town of Ashby shall be considered to be within  
3 the jurisdiction of the county of Worcester.

Section 1. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the right to make and alter the bylaws of the Corporation, subject to the power of the stockholders to change or repeal the same.

**The Board of Directors**

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five nor more than fifteen members.

Section 3. The Board of Directors shall have the right to elect and remove the officers and directors of the Corporation.

Section 4. The Board of Directors shall have the right to make and alter the bylaws of the Corporation.

SECTION 5. Section 1 of Chapter 100 of the Laws of 1907 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Board of Directors shall have the right to make and alter the bylaws of the Corporation, subject to the power of the stockholders to change or repeal the same."
