AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1 Section 3(2) (g) of Chapter 32 is hereby further amended by
- 2 adding the following after the last sentence in group 2: — “Probation
- 3 Officers and Court Officers employed by the Chief Adminis-
- 4 trative Justice of the Trial Court.”

The Constitution of the State of Kansas

As amended by the Constitution of 1895

AN ACT TO REVISE AND REISSUE THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF KANSAS

Section 1. That the Constitution of the State of Kansas, as amended by the Constitution of 1895, be revised and reissued in the form and to the effect hereinafter expressed.

Section 2. That the Governor is to publish within ninety days after the date of the adoption of this act a copy of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, as amended by the Constitution of 1895, in the form and to the effect hereinafter expressed.
