By Mr. Kirby, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 349) of Edward P. Kirby and Charles N. Decas for legislation to further regulate commercial shooting preserves. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COMMERCIAL SHOOTING PRESERVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by deleting clause (1) in the second
3 paragraph, and substituting therefor the following new
4 clause:—

5 (1) Each commercial shooting preserve shall be posted with
6 printed notices not more than one hundred fifty feet apart sup-
7 plied by the director to the permittee at cost.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
