In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPALACHIAN TRAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 58 is hereby amended by
2 inserting the following phrase after the words "and used for
3 recreational or conservation purposes;": —

4 and, of all land under the care and control of the department
5 of environmental management known as the Appalachian
6 Trail to which the federal government transfers its care and
7 control.

1 SECTION 2. Section 15A of chapter 58 is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the words "care and control of the federal
3 government", the following phrase: —

4 and, except land under the care and control of the depart-
5 ment of environmental management and used as part of what
6 is known as the Appalachian Trail and which was at the time
7 of its transfer to the Commonwealth under the care and con-
8 trol of the federal government.
