AN ACT REQUIRING HOSPITALS TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATION
RELATIVE TO COMPLIMENTARY HEALTH SERVICE PROVIDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 70E of Chapter 111 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 720 of the Acts of 1979,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after paragraph (m)
4 the following:—
5 (n) to be informed of complementary health service pro-
6 viders as are licensed or approved by the Commonwealth,
7 whether or not such practitioners are members of the staff of
8 the facility.

1 SECTION 2. Section 70E of Chapter 111 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 720 of the Acts of 1979,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after subparagraph
4 (h) the following:—
5 (i) to be informed of complementary health service pro-
6 viders as are licensed or approved by the Commonwealth,
7 whether or not such practitioners are members of the staff of
8 the facility.
