**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCREASING JUDICIAL SALARIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 211 of the General Laws is hereby amended to pro-  
2 vide as follows: —

3 *Section 1.* The chief justice of the Supreme Court shall receive  
4 a salary of eighty thousand dollars, and each associate justice  
5 a salary of seventy-seven thousand five hundred dollars.

6 *Section 2.* The chief justice of the appeals court and each  
7 associate justice shall receive a salary of seventy-seven thou-  
8 sand five hundred dollars.

9 *Section 3.* Each associate justice of the trial court shall  
10 receive a salary of seventy-five thousand dollars.

11 *Section 4.* The administrative justices of each of the courts  
12 shall receive a salary of seventy-seven thousand five hundred  
13 dollars.

14 *Section 5.* The chief administrative justice shall receive a  
15 salary of eighty thousand dollars.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS

- 1. That the University of Illinois be incorporated as a body corporate, with the following powers and privileges:
- 2. That the University of Illinois be authorized to acquire and hold real and personal estate, to sue and be sued, to contract, and to do all such things as natural persons may lawfully do.
- 3. That the University of Illinois be authorized to receive and hold any and all gifts, bequests, and donations of money, land, or other property, and to use the same for the purposes of the University.
- 4. That the University of Illinois be authorized to purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire any and all lands, buildings, or other property, and to use the same for the purposes of the University.
- 5. That the University of Illinois be authorized to sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of any and all lands, buildings, or other property, and to use the proceeds of such sale, lease, or disposal for the purposes of the University.
- 6. That the University of Illinois be authorized to borrow money, and to issue bonds or other securities, for the purposes of the University.
- 7. That the University of Illinois be authorized to receive and hold any and all gifts, bequests, and donations of money, land, or other property, and to use the same for the purposes of the University.
- 8. That the University of Illinois be authorized to purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire any and all lands, buildings, or other property, and to use the same for the purposes of the University.
