AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS AND THE DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to restore full collective bargaining rights to M.B.T.A. employees, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 19G of Chapter 161A as most recently amended by
- 2 Section 9 of Chapter 581 of the Acts of 1980 is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 At least 10 days prior to the issuance of the award, the ar-
- 5 bitrator shall meet with one representative of the M.B.T.A.
- 6 and one representative of the Union for the purpose of presen-
- 7 ting a draft of his award, and discussing its content. Each
- 8 representative shall be permitted full opportunity to give his
- 9 view of the award, but shall not vote on the award or compose
- 10 a separate opinion. The contents of the proposed award shall
- 11 remain confidential.
