SENATE No. 1523

By Mr. Reilly, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1523) of Martin T. Reilly for legislation to require results of certain referendum questions to be transmitted to the State Racing Commission within ninety days. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATE RACING COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 128A is hereby amended by adding the following sec-
2 tion 14B:

3 A certified copy of the results of a referendum question put
4 to the voters of a political subdivision as provided section 14
5 of chapter 128A shall be sent by secretary of state to the state
6 racing commission no later than 90 days after said election.
7 In the case of a referendum submitted to the voters of a
8 political subdivision regarding licenses for horse, harness, dog
9 racing and racing at fairs, the secretary of state shall send
10 the state racing commission a certified copy of the results of
11 said question within 90 days after the referendum question has
12 been submitted to the voters.

13 Further in the case of a referendum question submitted to
14 the voters of a city or town relative to the granting of licenses
15 for horse, harness, dog racing, and racing at fairs the clerk
16 of said city or town shall send to the state racing commission
17 a certified copy of the results of the referendum question no
18 later than 90 days after said election.
