**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE
JUSTICE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 9 of Chapter 211B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out the second sentence in subparagraph (iii) and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following sentence: —
- 4 The chief administrative justice may assign any non-judicial personnel
- 5 among the various departments, divisions or places for holding court, but
- 6 in no event shall any such transfer be more than a reasonable distance from
- 7 the place where such personnel is appointed, assigned or employed.
