AN ACT AUTHORIZING ASSISTANCE BY THE COMMONWEALTH IN ESTABLISHMENT OF DAY CARE FOR THE CHILDREN OF STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The state superintendent of buildings is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to provide suitable space in the City of Springfield
- 3 to be utilized as a day care center for the children of state
- 4 employees. Such day care center shall be subject to the re-
- 5 quirements for licensure of the Office for Children of the Com-
- 6 monwealth. The operator of such day care center shall pay
- 7 rent to the Commonwealth for any state tax revenue expend-
- 8 ed for the purpose of making improvements to the space
- 9 provided.
