**AN ACT EXEMPTING THE INCOME OF PERSONS IN THE ARMED FORCES FROM
STATE TAXATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
- 2 contrary, service pay of individuals in the armed services who are sta-
- 3 tioned outside the Commonwealth shall be exempt from the state income
- 4 tax. To qualify for such exemption, such individuals must show proof of
- 5 Massachusetts domicile.
