RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING AND INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO SPECTATOR VIOLENCE AT SPORTING EVENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chapter twenty of
2 the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-seven and most recently
3 revived and continued by chapter fourteen of the resolves of nineteen
4 hundred and seventy-nine is hereby revived and continued. Said com-
5 mission shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the
6 subject matter of current senate document numbered 1277, prohibiting
7 the sale of certain general admission tickets or right of entry to certain
8 events and current house document numbered 1715, requiring police pro-
9 tection at public sporting events or musical events.
10 Said commission shall report to the general court the results of its
11 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with
12 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by
13 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before
14 the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
