1 *Ordered*, That the Joint Committee on Banks and Banking
2 is hereby authorized to sit during the current session and dur-
3 ing the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making
4 an investigation and study of financial services available to
5 small businesses in the Commonwealth and such other related
6 matters as the Committee deems relevant. The Committee
7 shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the
8 subject matter of current Senate documents 6 and 712, relative
9 to establishing the Massachusetts Small Business Develop-
10 ment Bank.

11 Said Committee may report, from time to time, to the
12 General Court the results of its investigation and study and
13 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-
14 tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by fil-
15 ing the same with the clerk of the Senate on or before the last
16 Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
