The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE STATE TREASURER TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO THE CITY OF QUINCY TO ENABLE SAID CITY TO SATISFY AN OUTSTANDING JUDGMENT.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately enable the state treasurer to pay a certain sum of money to the city of Quincy, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of enabling the city of Quincy
2 to satisfy an outstanding judgment, the state treasurer is
3 hereby authorized and directed to pay to said city the sum of
4 seventeen million seven hundred and fifteen thousand nine
5 hundred and ninety-nine dollars which shall be in addition to
6 all other sums said city shall be entitled to receive from the
7 Commonwealth. Said amount shall be repaid to the Com-
8 monwealth in equal installments of one million seven hundred
9 and seventy-one thousand six hundred dollars over a period
10 of ten years commencing with fiscal year 1986 by way of a
11 deduction of said amount from the first local aid distribution
12 said city is entitled to receive in each of said years.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions
2 of Section 1, seventeen million seven hundred and fifteen thou-
3 sand nine hundred and ninety-nine dollars is hereby ap-
4 propriated from the local aid fund.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
