## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND BUSINESS REGULATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 6A of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following  
3 words: —“and the Community Antenna Television Commission.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 6A is hereby further amend-  
2 ed by adding at the end of the first paragraph, the following  
3 paragraph: — “The secretary of Consumer Affairs and Business  
4 Regulation shall have the authority to review and approve rules  
5 and regulations proposed by the agencies within the Executive  
6 Office. Such regulations will be deemed approved unless disap-  
7 proved within 15 days of submission to the Secretary.”

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
